People were amazed to watch her especially when she won. She loved hopping in the car and going to Atlantic City to Harrah's. If you didn't want to stay long, you sure didn't want to go with her. She stayed all night into the morning at times. She was a diehard Pittsburgh Steelers fan but she came out each week to watch the games with the NYG4 Life SC fan club. Other hobbies were knitting and reading.

Ann was a big traveler. She has been to Lake Tahoe, Jamaica, St. Maarten, French Riviera, Italy, Greece, Egypt, Norway, Sweden and several states in the US.

She attended many events with her family in South Carolina. She really enjoyed attending house music events with Columbia House Music Project South Carolina, going to Charlotte for house music events as well. She also enjoyed going to Myrtle Beach, Isle of Palms and Sullivan's Island. She was always on the go. She loved being with family and friends and doing things together. She was always there for her family and helped any way she could.
