June 22, 1979 - August 3, 2024

Mr. Christopher "Chris" Bracey, 45, of Chapin, South Carolina entered into eternal rest on Saturday, August 3, 2024 at the Lexington Medical Center. He was born June 22, 1979 in Columbia, South Carolina at Richland Memorial Hospital. He was born to Phyllis Bracey Hollins and the late Dennis Blackwell.

Chris matriculated through the public school systems of Charleston, South Carolina, Orlando, Florida; and Columbia, South Carolina where he graduated from A.C. Flora High School. Chris was baptized at Friendship Baptist Church where he gave his life over to Christ. Through all of his travels, he never removed his membership from Friendship Baptist Church.

ABE1 (AW/SW) Christopher L. Bracey USN Ret. was a proud veteran of the United States Navy. He joined the United States Navy on December 30, 1999, serving his country for 22 years until retiring and being honorably discharged on January 28, 2022. Chris served more than 11 years of sea duty becoming a Blue Nose Sailor during that time, crossing the arctic circle.

Simultaneously, Chris furthered his education, obtaining both his Associate and Bachelor Degrees in Criminal Justice from Columbia Southern University as well as countless military education.

Chris cherished his family and friends and spent countless hours documenting

his memories. Memories ranging from family occasions to his world travels were all meticulously documented via souvenirs, paintings and numerous photo albums. His love of documenting memories and storytelling led to his interest in photography, creating 'Streetlight Images' to share life through his lens.

As a creative, Chris enjoyed writing and was actively working on his first book and memoir. He also enjoyed restoring old school automobiles and gardening in support of his health as his life motto became "Health is Wealth". Chris was an avid traveler with his most recent travels across Africa, a lifelong dream.

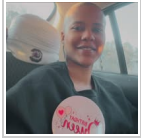

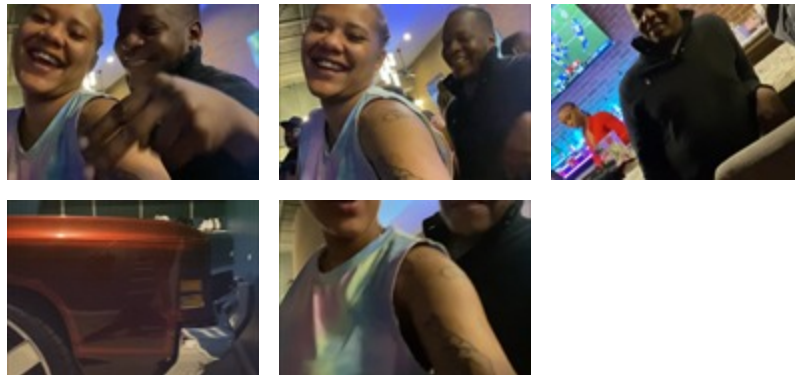
