He accepted Christ at an early age and attended Lawson Chapel Church, in Roxboro, NC.

He received his early education in the public schools of Roxboro, NC. After graduating high school he enlisted in the United States Army, in 1951 and was honorably discharged in 1953. During his time in the military he received several commendations. Following his service in the military, he became employed at Bethlehem Steel Corporation, in Sparrows Point, Maryland, and worked there for thirty-five years. While in Baltimore he was a member of Pharaoh's Social Club and the Hiram Masonic Lodge.

After retirement in 1993, Dailey relocated to Winnsboro, South Carolina, and drove school buses for Fairfield County School District for more than twenty years.
