David was always kindhearted and most of all loyal to his sisters. No matter the obstacle, David would move heaven and earth for his sisters Barbara "BJ" and Carolyn "Cat". That devotion was repaid in spades from his fierce yet darling sisters' tireless and selfless love shown to him.

David will be remembered for many things: his roaring laugh, the comfort with which he felt interrupting Barbara's business meeting to request a root beer, insisting that Carolyn bring him just the right loaf of bread, cheating at poker against his nieces and nephews, and the inside jokes and respect he held for his brother-in-law, Wayne. But most of all, David was a constant for our family. He was someone we could all rely on and we all cared for deeply. And though his earthly journey is complete, his love remains a constant, forever in our hearts and our lives.

David was preceded in death by three brothers Michael, Bennie, and Willie Crisp; two sisters, Patricia C. Norman and Gail Coleman; two step-brothers, Douglas and Andrew Crisp.
