Farry Dorothy Glasper, affectionately known as “Dot”, was born September 10, 1927, in the Talatha Community of Aiken, South Carolina, to the late Samuel and Farry Bell Bates Dicks. She peacefully slipped into the loving arms of her Savior on January 5, 2021, at ninety-three, while at home with family.

She attended Storm Branch Academy and later completed her education by earning a High School Equivalency Diploma. Further education included,

completing a training program for a Barber's License in the 1960's—making her one of Columbia's FIRST female barbers. Not one to be satisfied with being idle, at the ripe age of 75, she completed training and was certified as a nurse's assistant. Dorothy was a trailblazer for women and African-Americans in the community.

At an early age, Dorothy accepted Christ as her personal Savior while attending Zion Hill Missionary Baptist church. As a member of Trinity Baptist Church, under Reverend Bogan's pastoral care, she sang in the choir. She later joined Friendship Baptist Church under Reverend A.A. Dicks' pastoral care. At Friendship, she served on the Jubilee Choir and Benevolence Society. She was also a member of the Improved Benevolent & Protective Order Of Elks Of The World Primrose Temple #611.

She was preceded in death by two sons, Rayfield Jeter and Alexander Jeter.

She is survived by five daughters, Lorraine Booker, Lucretia Woodburn, Nazerine P. Rice, all of Columbia, SC, Vivialoria (Joe) Houston, of Martinez, GA, and Dorothy Angela (Harry) Profit, of Virginia Beach, VA, and a son Abraham (Chrystal) Jeter, Jr., of Cleveland, OH; four sisters, Penny Smith, Josephine Smiley, Nazerine Morgan, and Leola Dicks; and a host of grandchildren, great grandchildren, great-great grandchildren, and other relatives and friends.

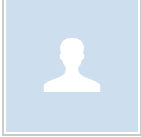
