Mrs. Dorothy Louise Millner Scott was born in Mayo, Virginia on September 19, 1935 to the late Jessie and Mary DeShazo Millner. She gracefully took her Master's hand and followed Him to rest in the presence of her beloved family and close friends on Thursday, February 9, 2017.

Mrs. Scott accepted Christ at an early age at Mayo Missionary Baptist Church which was her first place of worship. After relocating to Columbia, SC she became a faithful member of Gunter's Chapel Baptist Church until her health declined.

Dorothy was a graduate of George Washington Carver High School. Being a sports enthusiast, she played basketball and was the best cheerleader who could cut a rug with the best of them. She continued her education at Midlands Technical College where she earned an associates degree in Human Services. In 1957 it was duly noted that she was one of the few black obstetrics technicians at the John Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD and the old Columbia Hospital. Mrs. Scott changed professions to retail sales management where she retired from the Army Airforce Exchange Services (AAFES) in 1995.

Dorothy loved to dance, play Bingo, and was very stylish. She was compassionate, demonstrated agape love (in spite of the need to chastise) but was also a short fused firecracker when she needed to be. She was a risk taker, strong willed, was a great defender and referee who loved her husband, children and siblings.

She was married to Sergeant First Class (R) Donell Scott who preceded her in death along with her parents and nine siblings.
