Mr. Hamp Lee Williamson, 74, formerly of Aiken, South Carolina entered into eternal rest on Thursday, June 20, 2024 at Newark Beth Israel Medical Center in Newark, New Jersey. He was born 20 May 1950 to the late Hampton Lee Williamson and the late Reva Mae Morgan in Aiken, South Carolina.

Hamp graduated from Martha Schofield High School in Aiken, South Carolina. After high school, he attended Mississippi Valley State College where he was drafted into the United States Army as a Communications Center Specialist.

Hamp served honorably in the US Army from July 13, 1970 to February 29, 1972. During his tenure in the Military, he completed one Combat Tour to Vietnam and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service and Campaign Medals, Army Commendation Medal and Certificate of Achievement.
