Hazel Scott Rose was born on August 4, 1949 in Richland County. She was the second of nine children born to the late Howard and Rosa Macon Scott. Hazel entered into eternal rest on March 21, 2024 after a brief hospital stay.

Hazel attended the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina. Hazel graduated from C. A. Johnson High School, Class of 1967. Hazel was a member of the Social Dance Club. This club is a reflection of her attributes of poise and social graces. Hazel was also an essential member of The Rainbow Club which served as a virtual part of the community and sponsored community fundraisers. Hazel attended Allen University where she earned her associates degree in Business Administration.

As a young adult Hazel worked several years in Retail and later sought a career in healthcare where her 1st career move was Secretary for Richland Memorial Hospital in the Neurology Department. She later secured a position at Richland Memorial's Ambulatory Care Clinic. She retired in 2014 as the Business Administrator for Columbia's Comprehensive Behavioral Care.

Hazel was also an active member of The Order of Eastern Star where she achieved the highest ranking of The Rose of Seven Seals.
