Mr. John Stroman, Jr., 87, of Columbia, South Carolina, entered into eternal rest on February 8, 2025 at Prisma Health Baptist hospital. "Junior", as he was affectionately known to his family, was born in Bamberg, South Carolina on February 28, 1937. He was the son of the late John A. and Lousise Busby Stroman.

As a child he attended Canaan United Methodist Church in Cope, South Carolina. In 1956, he married his life long partner, Jeanette H. Stroman and thereafter, they moved to Columbia, South Carolina where they attended Second Nazareth Baptist Church. To this union, they had seven children. They joined Friendship Baptist Church in 1969 where he was a faithful member and became a part of the Trustee Board and the Homeless Feeding Ministry.

John was an air conditioning and refrigeration specialist at Southern Scales for twenty-five years and was the maintenance technician over multiple Lizard's Thicket restaurants until he retired in 2002. He was known by all and sought out by many for his ability to repair and maintain heating, air and refrigeration. He was known to be a jack of all trades.

John was a very gentle, loving and devoted husband to his late wife, Jeanette H. Stroman for 58 years. He enjoyed fishing, spending time with family and dancing at family functions. John was known for always having a clean car

and would be seen washing his car even if it was predicted to rain, his saying was " a clean car rides better". He made it clear that a dirty car was unacceptable and made sure that his daughters knew how to get the job done.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by his brother, Clifford Stroman and sister, Rosa Lee Donaldson.

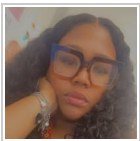
