Roger "Byrd" Drayton was born July 22, 1961 in Columbia SC to Jerome L. Drayton and the late Ora Bell Woods Drayton. After completing elementary school "Byrd" as he was affectionately known to his family, moved with his parents to Newark, New Jersey. Roger attended Weequahic High School of Newark, New Jersey, where he was full of excitement and his teachers encouraged him to enjoy learning because the time would past quickly. Byrd furthered his education by pursuing a Technical Engineering degree through evening classes at Seton Hall, an Ivory League College in South Orange, New Jersey. choices of lures and tactics may not have saved the world but it would save you from going home empty-handed when bringing back a big mouthed bass and a bucket of fish!

As a fisherman, his favorite seasons of the year were spring and fall when the air was cool and the colors were changing, when football watching had to take a back seat. He would tweet about good fishing spots. To him, it was better than him sitting and yelling while watching TV. Byrd rathered to be on the water as it was relaxing to him.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Ora Bell Woods Drayton whom he loved dearly

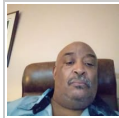
