He enlisted in the United States Army in 1956 after graduating from Carver Vocational Technical School (Baltimore). His 20- year military career included tours of duty in Germany, South Korea and Vietnam, and afforded him the opportunity to graduate from Columbia College (Columbia, MO) in 1976 with a Bachelor of Arts in General studies.

He retired from military service in 1976 with the rank of Master Sergeant. He also was a lifetime member of Kappa Alpha Psi fraternity. He wore many hats including that of a bank manager, private investigator, and claims investigator (South Carolina Department of Human Affairs). Bill married Janie Gilmore from Columbia, SC in 1990 and remained married until the date of his death.
