Again, she was always thinking about others and not just herself. Her greatest pride and joy in life was being an amazing Mom to her sonshine, Elijah and her beautiful princess, Zyon. She loved creating special memories with her children, making them smile and giving them all of her love. Yolanda's legacy will go on forever- she lived, she loved, and she accomplished her goals leaving an imprint on everyone that was blessed to meet and talk with her. Yolanda left this world a better place simply because she was here!

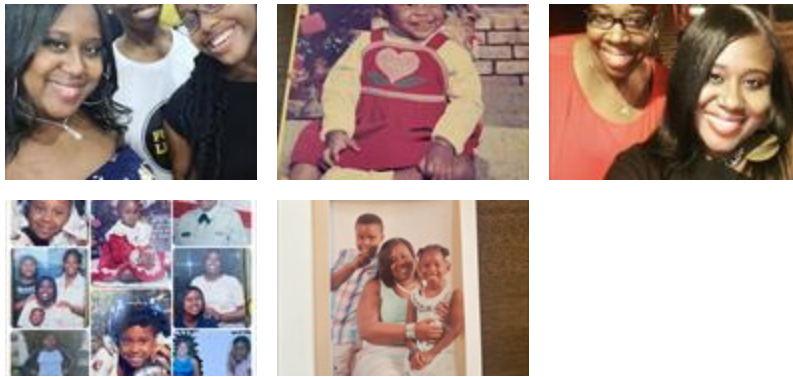
